Feedback Analysis and Action Taken Report 2019-20

The college collects the feedback on curriculum aspects and courses from different stakeholders such as the students, teachers, parents, alumni and Employers. The college maintains an IQAC as a quality consistence and quality enhancement measure. The IQAC ensures and analyze the academic excellence at student and faculty levels through feedback mechanism with periodical analysis.

The college of thoroughly reviews the curriculum for every academic year. In supervision of IQAC, various departments and committees reinforce the curriculum by incorporating updated information and social issues. The college collects the feedback manually on Curriculum which is prescribed by the university, further college website invites all stockholder to provide feedback through provided link.

The college conducts annual Alumni Meet, in which suggestions and feedback is received from Alumni students. Feedback from industrial management, R & D establishments and professionals is obtained through college website's feedback link. The provided feedback data is analyzed and presented to the university for necessary implementation in curriculum.

Feedback Analysis 2019-20

1.Students Feedback on Curriculum

- 40.33% students responded as Very Good, 34.25% as Excellent and 16.57% as good on curriculum regarding Learning Values (In terms of Concept, Knowledge, Manual Skills etc).
- 38.67% students responded as Very Good, 31.49% as Excellent and 18.78% as good regarding Relevance of the units in Syllabus.
- 47.51% students responded as Very Good, 39.78% as excellent and 7.73% as good on curriculum regarding Allocations of period and weightage.
- 43.65% students responded as Very Good, 38.12% as excellent and 8.29% as good on curriculum regarding Fundamental Coverage.
- 46.41% students responded as Very Good, 30.39% as Excellent and 9.39% as good on Size of syllabus in terms of the load on the student.

- 41.44% students responded as very good, 38.67% as excellent and 11.05% as good on curriculum regarding Extra learning or self learning considering the design of the courses.
- 40.22% students responded as Excellent, 36.96% as Very Good and 11.96% as good on curriculum regarding Clarity and relevance of textual reading material (Library).
- 45.30% students responded as Excellent, 35.91% as Very Good and 13.26% as good on curriculum regarding objectives stated for each of the Syllabus/Course.

2.Teachers Feedback on Curriculum 2019-20

- 73.68% teachers responded as strongly agree and 21.05% responded as agree regarding Syllabus is suitable to the course.
- 52.63% teachers responded as strongly agree and 31.58% responded as agree regarding Syllabus is need based.
- 68.42% teachers responded as strongly agree and 21.05% responded as agree regarding Aims and objectives of the syllabi are well defined and clear to teachers and students.
- 73.68% teachers responded as strongly agree and 10.53% responded as agree regarding course/syllabus has good balance between theory and practical.
- 84.21% teachers responded as strongly agree and 5.26% responded as agree regarding course/syllabus of this subject increased my knowledge and perspective in the subject area.
- 63.16% teachers responded as agree and 31.58% responded as strongly agree regarding books prescribed/listed as reference materials are relevant, updated and appropriate.

3. Parents Feedback on Curriculum 2019-20

- 62.73% parents responded as strongly agree and 21.82% responded as agree regarding holistic development of students is ensured by participation of students in various sports, cultural and co-curricular activities organized throughout the year.
- 63.64% parents responded as strongly agree and 20% responded as agree regarding students are sensitized towards cross cutting issues like gender equality, environment and sustainability, ethics and values etc., through relevant courses in the curriculum as well as through community service participation in various awareness campaigns on socially relevant issues etc.
- 64.55% parents responded as strongly agree and 23.64% responded as agree regarding academic flexibility embedded in the curriculum provides opportunities to students to pursue their interest by choosing from a vast number of pathways / electives from own area / specialization as well as from other areas.

- 70.91% parents responded as strongly agree and 19.09% responded as agree regarding curriculum has been designed to make students industry ready by imparting analytical and reasoning, language and soft skills in addition to technical competencies.
- 53.64% parents responded as strongly agree and 22.73% responded as agree regarding the curriculum is outcome based and the expected outcomes, through various courses, are attained.

4. Alumni Feedback on Curriculum 2019-20

- 30% alumni responded as agree and 25% responded as strongly agree regarding contents of the Syllabus were revised at reasonable intervals.
- 35% alumni responded as strongly agree and 20% responded as agree regarding course/ syllabus increased knowledge and understanding of the subject studied.
- 37.5% alumni responded as strongly agree and 30% responded as agree regarding Course helped in developing personality.
- 55% alumni responded as strongly agree and 30% responded as agree regarding prescribed books were relevant, updated and appropriate.
- 45% alumni responded as strongly agree and 30% responded as agree regarding Course meet contemporary requirements.
- 47.5% alumni responded as strongly agree and 40% responded as agree regarding syllabus was need based as per the requirement of the job/industry.

5. Employers Feedback on Curriculum 2019-20

- 41.67% employers responded as strongly agree and 33.33% responded as agree regarding ability to contribute to the goal of the organization.
- 37.5% employers responded as strongly agree and 25% responded as agree regarding technical knowledge/ skill Ability to manage/leadership Innovativeness.
- 50% employers responded as strongly agree and 37.5% responded as agree regarding Involvement in social activities.
- 58.33% employers responded as strongly agree and 41.67% responded as agree regarding ability and motivation for social activity.
- 54.55% employers responded as strongly agree and 45.45% responded as agree regarding overall impression about their performance.
